RULES

- Students must be aged 15 -18 to participate (or must turn 15 by December 31st 2022)
- Students must form teams of 4
- A student cannot be part of two different teams
- Students must live in the Balearic Islands
- All entries must be student's own work
- We cannot accept projects created in Google Drive, or any projects created in platforms that have restricted access.
- We do not accept projects about recycling or plastic clean-up projects.



YOUR PROJECT OBJECTIVE

The objective of your project will be to **REDUCE** the amount of plastic that is produced by companies and/or used by consumers in our everyday lives. We want to encourage and promote solutions that aim to solve the root cause of the problems of plastic pollution: **overproduction and overconsumption of plastic products**, and in particular of single-use plastics (including bioplastics). Base your projects on the three most important Rs:

REFUSE REDUCE REUSE


IMPORTANT: This project does not focus on recycling, nor on replacing single-use plastic items with single use items of a different material (e.g. with paper or bioplastic). Projects focused on recycling or clean-ups will NOT be considered.

We encourage you to consider the interest and talents of your team members, and think of creative ways of how you can apply them to develop an inspiring project! You can ask yourself...



EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR PHASE 1

Once you send us your ideas, we will look at the following criteria:

- **RELEVANCE** To what extent does your idea help reduce plastic use / consumption?
- INNOVATIVE THINKING Get creative! We want you to put forward new ideas to reduce the amount of plastic produced and / or consumed in everyday life.
- **PRESENTATION AND CLARITY** How well is your idea presented? Is it easy for us to understand? Is it easy for others to understand? The way you deliver the message is important!
- **FEASIBILITY** Is the idea realistic? Can you put part, or all of it, into action if it's selected for PHASE 2?
- **TEAMWORK AND COLLABORATION** Working together is always the best way forward, not just amongst team members, but with everyone around you. Don't be afraid to get others involved!



EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR PHASE 2

- ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT This is our most important criteria. How much does it help reduce plastic use / consumption?
- **INNOVATIVE THINKING** Get creative! We want you to put forward new ideas to reduce the amount of plastic produced and / or consumed in everyday life.
- AWARENESS and INSPIRATION Educate people about the issues of single-use plastic and motivate them to take action against plastic pollution.
- SCIENTIFIC ACCURACY For every decision you take, make sure you are basing it in FACTS. If you are unclear or unsure on something, our team of scientists at Save The Med are always happy to help you with advice.
- **TEAMWORK AND COLLABORATION** Working together is always the best way forward, not just amongst team members, but with everyone around you.
- **PRESENTATION AND EVIDENCE** Your work should be clear and well presented. Provide evidence of your efforts and achievements. Take photos, videos and write down summaries of your work sessions, who you spoke to, where you went, tell us about your challenges and finally measure your impact: how much plastic your project is/can reduce and outreach how many people it has involved. The more "evidence" you collect of your activities and efforts, the more we will take it into account during judging.

PLAY TO YOUR STRENGTHS

Everyone is unique in their own way! Consider the interest and talents of your team members, and think of creative ways of how you can apply them to develop your project.

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HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR IDEAS

IMPORTANT: We cannot accept projects/links or surveys created in Google Drive, or any projects created in platforms that have restricted access.

If you made a video, song or online website and social media channels, please include all links. If you made an art piece, organised an event or conducted presentations and workshops you can make a video or take photos to send to us via email. If you developed a business proposal you can send us a PDF document via email and so on.

We reserve the right to use student work for promotional purposes in any and all media. All work will be credited to the students.



Is the sign-up free?

Who can sign-up?

The project is open to all students in the Balearic Islands aged 15-18 (or turning 15 by December 31st 2022).

What language should my project be in?

Your project can be in English, Spanish or Catalan.

Do I have to know how to sail to get on the boat?

No previous experience is needed to join. All you need is a positive attitude and willingness to learn! You will also need to sign an agreement form and be in good health before coming on board.

What will happen to our project afterwards?

All teams will be invited to participate in the Changemakers Event. All projects will be featured online. If potential funders and/or investors find feasible ideas among the projects, students might be offered a possibility to develop their projects further.
